NEWS FROM CURACAO

JUNE 2017

Greetings Brethren:

We are trusting God for a successful summer meeting. Now, we are just two weeks away from the official dates of the campaign, July 9-13th. We are looking forward to welcoming four of the campaigners from the Oxford Church of Christ in Oxford Alabama, the overseeing congregation. They will be arriving on July the 5th . Most of them are coming for the first time. I guess they are excited to make the trip. With some new ideas in mind, our endeavors will focus primarily on these three areas in the work.

First, conducting a Vacation Bible School activity with the youths of the island. Although some of the parents use the event as a daycare center, still we believe it's an opportunity to share the gospel. In part, we teach the kids and make acquaintances with their families; we show the parents that the welfare of their Children is our concern. Unlike the past few years, the event will take place in the church's building auditorium this coming July. Probably, we would have to operate with fewer kids during the three days meeting because of limited spaces and other physical facilities. However, we look forward to a thrilling and productive VBS. We have also written an article this year to share as we go; it is entitled "Children are the future." It emphasizes the need for everyone to do his or her part in training, protecting and motivating the Children of our community for tomorrow. It begins with a quote from the late Nelson Mandela, which says "Children are our greatest treasure; they are our future."

Secondly, teaching from house to house, village by village is another area we will explore in the July mission. We have prepared some lessons, flyers, tracts, and Bible courses for that effort. Thanks to brother Charles Dollahite from the Oxford church most of the materials are already in print. Starting from July 6th, the distribution will commence as soon as they arrive on Curacao. Additionally, we will make study contacts as we progress on the field. Soul-winning will be our top priority. Therefore, we will adjust whenever that is necessary to declare the gospel to those who express a concern for it.

Finally, preaching the message during the evening services will also be part of the overall work. For that, we have selected the theme "***Build all thing according to the pattern.***" Minister Mike Benson, the preacher of the Oxford Church of Christ, will share the word from the 9-13th of July. It is our hope that the saved and the unsaved would understand God's pattern for New Testament Christianity and would Sunday, June 11, 2017 resolve to build upon it as God has instructed in his word. Please pray that all would go well for that endeavor. Also, pray for the safe travel of the campaigners on July 5th .
