Has God Ever Been Caught Off Guard?

Has God ever been caught off guard?

Has God ever said to Himself, "I never saw that coming?"

Has God ever thought, "Boy, that was a big surprise; I didn't know that was going happen"?

Premillennialism says, in essence, "Yes."

You see, premillennialism claims that the Jews thwarted God's eternal plan (Eph. 3:9-11) and *unexpectedly* rejected Christ.

It agrees that Jesus *said* the kingdom was at hand (Mat. 4:17), but it denies that ever came into reality.

It says the Jews threw the Father a curve and forced Him to institute the church as a temporary, stop -gap measure until the millennial kingdom could be set up on earth from Jerusalem for a thousand years.

But think about the implications of this ill-conceived and dangerous view.

It implies that mankind was so unpredictable that the Father in heaven was incapable of knowing, seeing and realizing that the Jews would reject the Lord (cf. Isa. 53; Luke 18:31-33; 24:44-46; Acts 2:23; 1 Cor. 15:3-4).

It suggests that God is limited and certainly not omniscient.

It says that He is weak, that His foreknowledge is restrained and that He could see the birth of His Son, but He did not plan or see the vicarious death of His Son.

The premillennial view implies that the Jews caught God by surprise.

Good reader, the next time a friend insists that the kingdom and the church are not the same institution (Mat. 16:18-19; Col. 1:13; Rev. 1:6), and that the kingdom will one day be set up on earth, ask him kindly, "Do you realize what you're saying about God?"

Has God EVER been caught off guard?

"Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient times *things* that are not *yet* done, Saying, 'My counsel shall stand, And I will do all My pleasure" (Isa. 46:10; cf. 42:9; Psm. 147:4-5; Rom. 11:33; Acts 17:31; John 14:3).
